2. Recipients will be notified on Wednesday, September 30, 2020, and announced at the Massachusetts Chapter of the Institute of Transportation Engineers (MAITE) at their annual meeting on Thursday, October 1, 2020.
3. Candidate recipient recommendations for the scholarship may be submitted by faculty members or students at **accredited Civil Engineering** schools in the States of New England, or by Members or Affiliate Members of the New England Section of the Institute of Transportation Engineers.
4. The 2020 Award recipient **must** be a student at an accredited Civil Engineering school in one of the New England States.
5. Applicants should demonstrate a **strong commitment** to the discipline of **Transportation Engineering** in their coursework and outside activities.
6. The Scholarship Award may be made in equal installments by quarter or semester for the 2020-2021 academic year, or in a single installment at the discretion of the committee. You **must furnish** official confirmation of enrollment in the required course of study along with a copy of your course grades for the previous academic period prior to the disbursement of each portion of the Award.
7. While all students meeting the above requirements are eligible, preference may be given to undergraduate students.
